LEADERSHIP CAMP

Whether you're a new student leader, coach or an FCA veteran, you'll leave camp empowered to lead on your campus, in your community or on your team. Through worship, fellowship, fun, and training, you'll be challenged to lead like Christ; loving God and others for the advancement of HIS kingdom. Our time together will be powerful and life-changing! This camp is intended for current or potential adult and student FCA leaders.

CHECKING IN

Upon arrival at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly, on Monday, July 6th, come to **Eureka Hall** to complete registration. Camp registration is between **12:00 p.m. and 2:30 p.m.** The program officially begins with the Opening Team Meeting at 3:00 p.m.

For those who register online, check-in will be a breeze! We'll confirm all of your waivers and payment. Then you'll receive your camp t-shirt, Bible, nametag and lanyard. If you have medications, you'll meet with our medical team.

If, for some (extremely rare) reason, registration is not completed online, the following items listed below are needed to complete your registration at check-in:

- **Funds for Remaining Balance**
- **Student Permission Waiver Form**

These items are REQUIRED to be completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian in order to

participate in activities at camp. Students will not be allowed to participate in camp without them.

EARLY ARRIVAL

Camp housing will not be available until **after 12:00 p.m. Monday, July 6th**. **The first camp meal is Monday evening at 6:15 p.m.** Any housing or meals prior to Monday's dinner will have to be arranged and paid for by the camper. **Please eat lunch before arriving on campus for check-in.**

FEEES

All unpaid fees are due before check-in at camp. Cancellations can be made by calling the Camp Registrar, at **(919) 621-6921**. **Refund Schedule:**

- On or before **June 8th**: Full refund
- On or before **Noon on July 6th**: \$100 IS NON-REFUNDABLE
- **After the start of camp: \$415 is NON-REFUNDABLE.**

Substitutions can be made as late as the time of on-site check-in.

DIRECTIONS

From the West

From I-40 East: Take exit 64 for Black Mountain/Montreat. Turn right at bottom of ramp. Take Highway 9 South past Ingles to the fork in the road and veer right on to Blue Ridge Rd. Drive .9 miles and turn left at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge Assembly Rd. Proceed to the end of the road and our entrance.

From US 70/Tunnel Road: Head east towards Black Mountain. Across from Health Ridge Pharmacy turn right onto Blue Ridge Road. Go .5 miles and turn right at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge Assembly Road. Proceed to the end of the road and our entrance. Follow signs to Eureka Hall for Check-in.

From the East

From I-40 West: Take exit 64 for Black Mountain/Montreat. Turn left at bottom of ramp. Take Highway 9 South past Ingles to the fork in the road and veer right on to Blue Ridge Road. Drive .9 miles and turn left at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge Assembly Rd. Proceed to the end of the road and our entrance.

From US 70/Tunnel Road: Head west towards Asheville. Across from Health Ridge Pharmacy turn left onto Blue Ridge Road. Go .5 miles and turn right at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge Assembly Road. Proceed to the end of the road and our entrance. Follow signs to Eureka Hall for Check-in.

SHOPPING FCA

Enrollment fees cover all essentials, but you will no doubt want spending money for incidentals and extras such as FCA merchandise. We will be selling FCA t-shirts, hats, water bottles, hoodies, etc. You will not want to miss out on all the great merchandise! A Camp Snack Store will also be open during free time and socials.

INSURANCE

FCA will only provide secondary insurance coverage for the camper during the stay at camp. In case of injury or illness, campers will need to provide proof of insurance coverage at the time of treatment via their permission waivers. Campers not covered by family insurance will be cared for.

WHAT TO WEAR & BRING

Modest athletic attire is required during camp. Keep your clothing and any equipment simple. Modest bathing suits are also required for the pool during free time (if too much is showing for both guys and girls you will be asked to wear a t-shirt).

You will need to bring sunscreen, bug spray, towels, washcloths, soap, shampoo and an alarm clock.

You may want to bring your own water bottle, small backpack, and sun block. A camp notebook will be provided, and pen will be needed for Team Meetings.

You **DO NOT** have to bring a pillow, sheets, or a blanket; you **DO** have to bring towels/washcloths.

Adults and children should bring suitable clothing and shoes for sports.

Do not bring jewelry, iPads, video games, or other expensive items that you don't want walking away or damaged. *FCA is not responsible for any lost or stolen property or merchandise of campers.*

Camp officially ends at **11:00 a.m.**, after the Team Chapel on Friday, July 10th. You may pick up your campers at **Eureka Hall** upon check-out. If you have further questions, please contact the Camp Registrar at **(919) 621-6921**.
