### The Leadership Camp

Whether you're a rookie student leader, huddle coach or a seasoned veteran, you'll be engaged, equipped, and empowered to pursue Christ and influence your teams, schools, and communities after attending this camp.

### Checking In

Upon arrival at the **YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly**, on **Monday, July 12<sup>th</sup>**, come to **Eureka Hall** to complete registration between **12:00 p.m.** and **2:00 p.m.** **Camp officially begins with the Opening Team Meeting at 3:00 p.m.**

### Early Arrival

Camp housing will not be available until after **12 p.m., Monday, July 12<sup>th</sup>**. The first camp meal is dinner on Monday at 6:15 p.m. **Any housing/meals prior to Monday's dinner need to be arranged and paid for by the camper. Please eat lunch before check-in.**

### Fees

**All unpaid fees are due before check-in at camp.** Cancellations can be made as late as July 7<sup>th</sup> by calling the Camp Registrar, Kelsi Pack, at **(864) 473-7496**. All fees, **EXCEPT A \$100 DEPOSIT**, will be refunded in August if you cancel your enrollment before July 7.

Substitutions can be made as late as the time of on-site check-in.

**After camp begins, \$400 is non-refundable, if you do not attend!**

### Directions

**From the west:** From I-40 East: Take exit 64 for Black Mountain/Montreat. Turn right at bottom of ramp. Take Highway 9 South past Ingles Market to the fork in the road and veer right on to Blue Ridge Road. Drive .9 miles and turn left at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge Assembly Rd. Proceed to the end of the road and entrance.

From US 70/Tunnel Road: Head east towards Black Mountain. Across from Health Ridge Pharmacy turn right onto Blue Ridge Road. Go .5 miles and turn right at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge

Assembly Road. Proceed to the end of the road and entrance. Follow signs to Eureka Hall for Check-in.

**From the east:** From I-40 West: Take exit 64 for Black Mountain/Montreat. Turn left at bottom of ramp. Take Highway 9 South past Ingles Market to the fork in the road and veer right on to Blue Ridge Road. Drive .9 miles and turn left at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge Assembly Rd. Proceed to the end of the road and entrance.

From US 70/Tunnel Road: Head west towards Asheville. Across from Health Ridge Pharmacy turn left onto Blue Ridge Road. Go .5 miles and turn right at the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly sign onto Blue Ridge Assembly Road. Proceed to the end of the road and entrance. Follow signs to Eureka Hall for Check-in.

### FCA Camp Store

Enrollment fees cover all essentials, but you will no doubt want spending money for incidentals and extras such as FCA merchandise. We will be selling FCA t-shirts, hats, water bottles, hoodies, etc. **You will not want to miss out on all the great merchandise, some of which will be available only at this camp!**

### Insurance

FCA will only provide secondary insurance coverage for the camper during the stay at camp. In case of injury or illness, campers will need to provide proof of insurance coverage at the time of treatment via their permission waivers. Campers not covered by family insurance will be cared for.

**Campers must bring towels, washcloths, & their toiletries.**

### What to Wear and Bring

Modest athletic attire is required during camp. Keep your clothing simple. Bring athletic shoes and clothing that you will need for competitions. Modest bathing suits is also required for the pool during free time *(if too much is showing for both guys and girls you will be asked to wear a t-shirt . . . let's not cause each other to stumble - 1 Corinthians 10:31-33).*



You may want to bring your own water bottle, small backpack (**also available at Camp Store**), and sun block. Bring a camp notebook and pen for Team Meetings and FCA Training.

All campers should bring suitable clothing and shoes for sports.

**Do not bring jewelry or other expensive items that you don't want walking away. FCA is not responsible for any lost or stolen property or merchandise of campers.**

### Departing Camp

Camp officially ends at **11:00 a.m.**, after the Team Chapel on **Friday, July 16<sup>th</sup>**. You may pick up your campers at Eureka Hall upon check-out. If you have further questions, please contact **Kelsi**, our Camp Registrar at **(864) 473-7496**.

### COVID-19

**COVID** protocols will be strictly followed at camp from check-in to check-out. Each camper is required to bring a **MASK** to wear inside and when proper social distancing cannot be maintained. **Hand sanitizer** will be generously distributed around camp, but it would be preferable for each camper to bring his/her own bottle. If your camper exhibits symptoms within 72 hours or has direct contact with someone who has a confirmed case of COVID within 72 hours, of the start of camp, **DO NOT SEND THEM**. COVID symptoms include:

- **Fever of 100.4 or more**
- **Chills**
- **Shortness of breath**
- **Headache**
- **Loss of taste or smell**
